MOTION TO CONSOLIDATE,  
STAY CERTAIN CLAIMS, AND  
DISMISS CERTAIN CLAIMS**

1 **ORDER**

2 GOOD CAUSE HAVING BEEN SHOWN, the Court hereby GRANTS  
3 Plaintiffs TCL Communication Technology Holdings, Ltd., TCT Mobile Limited,  
4 and TCT Mobile (US), Inc. (together, "TCL") and Defendants Telefonaktiebolaget  
5 LM Ericsson and Ericsson Inc.'s (together, "Ericsson") Joint Motion to Consolidate  
6 this matter ("the California Action") with the related case, *Ericsson Inc., et al. v.*  
7 *TCL Communication Technology Holdings, LTD, et al.*, Case No. 2:15-cv-02370-  
8 JVS-JC (the "Transferred Action"). The California Action and the Transferred  
9 Action are consolidated for all purposes (but not merged), and governed by the  
10 scheduling order issued in the California Action on May 1, 2015, including any  
11 future amendments and revisions thereto, and joined in the same FRAND trial  
12 currently set for October 11, 2016.


13 It is further ORDERED that all documents filed in the cases shall reflect both  
14 captions and case numbers. For administrative convenience, documents shall be  
15 filed only in the California Action.

16 It is further ORDERED that all of Ericsson and TCL's patent infringement  
17 claims in the Transferred Action shall be stayed until further order of the Court.

18 It is further ORDERED that the docket in in the Transferred Action be  
19 corrected to reflect the dismissal without prejudice of Ericsson's declaratory  
20 judgment claims on TCL's patents.
